

Do you have trouble breathing when it's hot outside? Do you need help paying your electric bill this summer?

If so, you <u>may</u> qualify for the HEAP Summer Crisis Program.

HEAP Summer Crisis Program

The Summer Crisis Program (SCP) begins July 1 and runs through September 30. The SCP is designed to help qualified households pay for summer cooling. Through the SCP, eligible Lake & Geauga County households can receive a one-time payment on electric bills AND/OR a fan or an air conditioner. Air conditioners and fans are available on a limited basis and will be given out on a first-come, first-served basis.

Households must have a gross income that falls at or below 175% of the federal poverty level AND meet <u>ONE</u> of the following eligibility criteria:

- a household member who is over the age of 60;
- provide original physician documentation of medical necessity;
- or have a disconnection notice.

We cannot pay current PIPP payments. Copays may be required. An in-person appointment is required.
