We wanted to make you aware that Lifeline has been awarded funding through the Ohio Development Services Agency and Governor Mike DeWine's efforts to provide a safety net for residents struggling financially due to the impact of COVID-19. Our Home Relief Fund launched November 2 and, at the current time, runs through December 31, 2021.

Our mission at Lifeline is to fight poverty and to help ensure that our local residents and communities thrive—a bigger challenge than ever during an international pandemic. We're thrilled to have this Home Relief Fund to assist our local residents who have been impacted by COVID-19, either medically or financially.

The Home Relief Fund provides assistance with rent, mortgages and electric and water/sewer disconnection notices. We have partnered with Fair Housing Resource Center to triage and provide intake for the Home Relief Fund for both rent and mortgage assistance. They can be reached at 440-392-0147.
