

### **Retirement Announcement**


GMHA's Current Fiscal Manager will be retiring at the end of October.


Lynn Buescher has enjoyed working for GMHA for the last 12 years and is looking forward to relaxing and enjoying time with her family.

## Tips on How to Make This Time of Year Safe for Your Pets:

## A Note From the Public Housing Manager and Maintenance Supervisor

Tenants need to place trash cans out in the morning on your scheduled trash day and they must be placed back at your unit at the end of the day.

GMHA has received complaints from fellow community members regarding garbage being blown around out of cans that are too full, people other than tenants are using the cans, and animals tearing out garbage due to trash cans sitting out all week. Should this issue persist, you will be charged labor for maintenance to roll your can back to the unit if it is sitting out 24 hours past pick up day.

Waste Management will not pick up anything that is not in the can.

Income Reporting: ALL income must be reported, whether it is Child Support, Social Security, wages from a job, unemployment, or OWF from the Department of Human Services etc. This includes income for all household members. HUD has a system in place, called EIV [Enterprise Income Verification System] that can pull income sources. It is important to us that you understand these policies.
